AUCTION CHANGES : The following changes to the auction proceedings have been enacted and are now in effect :

1. The Treasurer will keep change on hand.
2. Lots must be paid for when they are sold and before they are received by the buyer. Change will be made at this time.
3. The club waives its commission on all lots.
4. The number of lots will be limited to 10 for any one consignee.
5. Auction time will be closely monitored.
6. No lose coins excepted. All lots must have holders.
7. Lots must have numbers for reference.
8. All lots must be accompanied by auction forms filled out in duplicate.
 - A. One copy for the auctioneer.
 - B. One copy for the Treasurer.

9. Consignees with more than 10 lots may submit extra lots for auction, but extra lots will be auctioned only after all other lots and if time permits.

Auction forms are available from the Secretary Darlene Corio. You will be given four sheets per request. Please list only ten lots per form, Use a second form if you have more than 10 items. If anyone who frequently has lots in the auctions would like additional forms please let the secretary know and I will have extra sheets printed out for you.
